

Drawing Celtic Knots on a square grid

Follow the steps from left to right.

- 1) Draw the bounding box.
- 2) Add a dot in the center of each square.
- 3 (and 4) Build up a basketweave pattern inside the bounding box.
- 5) Go round the corners and walls.
- 6) Colour in the background to make the knot pop.

Note: Knots can be transferred to scroll by taping the grid paper to the back of the scroll, and pricking through both the paper and the scroll with a pin. After that the center dots can be added and the knot drawn lightly, in pencil, on the front, before inking and colouring.
